

2,600 cops on duty for nomination day

KUALA LUMPUR: Some 2,693 policemen will be deployed during nomination day on Saturday. City police chief Commissioner Datuk Seri Mazlan Lazim said out of the total personnel that will be deployed, 361 are police officers, 2,303 rank and file policemen and 29 are police civilian staff.

"Police from all six districts in the city namely Sentul, Wangsa Maju, Brickfields, Dang Wangi, Cheras and Putrajaya will be involved in ensuring that the nomination process is incident-free," he said after attending the state-level 48th Cadet Police Corps anniversary celebration at the KL police headquarters yesterday.

Mazlan said 12 parliamentary seats - Kepong, Batu, Wangsa Maju, Segambut, Setiawangsa, Titiwangsa, Bukit Bintang, Lembah Pantai, Seputeh, Cheras, Bandar Tun Razak and Putrajaya - will be monitored by the city police.

The nomination centre in Kepong is the Jinjang Utara multipurpose hall; Batu (SMK Sentul Utama hall); Wangsa Maju (SMK Wangsa Melawati hall); Segambut (SRK Bukit Damansara); Setiawangsa (Stadium Titiwangsa); Titiwangsa (SMK Aminuddin Baki hall); Bukit Bintang (SMK Victoria hall); Lembah Pantai (Bukit Bandaraya community centre); Seputeh (SMK Bandar Baru Sri Petaling hall); Cheras (SK Seri Bintang Selatan hall); Bandar Tun Razak (DBKL Training Institute hall) and Putrajaya (Kompleks Kejiranan Presint 9). - By Ashwin Kumar
