

## **Vivekananda beat RMC to crown**

SMK Vivekananda edged favourites Royal Military College (RMC) 2-1 to clinch the Kuala Lumpur Schools Bangsar Zone Under-15 hockey title yesterday and in the process shattered RMC's dream of a sixth straight title.

After finishing runners-up the last four years, Vivekananda finally walked tall at the Kuala Lumpur Hockey Stadium in Pantai.

Vivekananda team coach Abraham Joseph Raj said the win was a pleasant surprise but overdue as they had met RMC in four previous finals and always ended up disappointed.

But the coach believes that his faith in the team played a major part in their win yesterday.

First time semi-finalists, SMK Bukit Bandaraya took third place when they sneaked past SMK Bandar Tasik Selatan 1-0.

In the semi-finals RMC beat SMK Bandar Tasik Selatan 2-0 while SMK Vivekananda beat SMK Bukit Bandaraya 3-0.
