

2,000 for treasure hunt fun run

SOME 2,000 youths are expected to take part in the second YBM-PUTRA Treasure Hunt Fun Run to be held this Sunday, at the Putra-LRT's Dang Wangi Station.

The treasure hunt is part of the one-day carnival jointly organised by the Malaysian Youth Foundation (YBM) and Putra LRT.

The treasure hunt is opened to youths aged 15 to 25. The prizes are RM200 cash and a hamper for the champion, RM150 cash and hamper for the runner-up and RM100 and hamper for the third place winner.

About 6,000 people are expected to visit the carnival this year which will be opened from 10am to 7pm.

Projek Usahasama Transit Ringan Automatik Sdn Bhd (Putra) managing director Ridza Abdoh Salleh said last year 1,500 participants took part in the hunt and 3,000 visitors came to the carnival.

This year's activities include a colouring competition, carrom tournament, karaoke contest, creative cooking competition, mini concert and sports programmes by Rakan Muda's Youth Squad.

Ridza said this at a presentation ceremony of 500 Putra-LRT passes to five schools in Klang Valley by Youth and Sports Department director-general Datuk Raja Ruslan Raja Samah at KL Sentral in Kuala Lumpur recently.

The schools were SMK Bukit Bandaraya, SMK Bangsar, SMK Seri Pantai, SMK Convent Bukit Nanas and SMK (P) Methodist.

Also present at the ceremony was Youth Foundation chairman Datuk Suhaimi Ibrahim.
