

VI out to exact revenge

VICTORIA Institution (VI) will be out for revenge and to turn last year's

silver to gold when they meet the Royal Military College (RMC) in the finals of the Kuala Lumpur Schools (Bangsar zone) boys' Under-18 hockey tournament at the National Hockey Stadium in Bukit Jalil.

The match is a repetition of the 2001 tournament, where RMC took the crown.

RMC were through to the final after they beat SMK Bandar Tasik Selatan 2-1 yesterday, while Victoria Institution nailed SMK Bukit Bandaraya 3-1.

In the Sentul zone Under-19 boys' matches, Group B's SMK Raja Ali beat SMK La Salle 1-0, while in group C, SMK Agama Kuala Lumpur beat SMK Maxwell 2-0.

In the last match of the day, group C's SMK Bandar Baru Sentul bowed to SMK Segambut 0-2.

Teams will play their deciding matches today to see who will top the respective groups at the Tun Razak Stadium in Jalan Duta.
