

Sri Sentosa the overall champs

SMK Sri Sentosa, powered by multi-gold medallist Ng Ki Lian, won the Kuala Lumpur Schools (Bangsar Zone) Boys' Under-18 4x400m relay for their

36th gold medal of the championships at the National Stadium in Bukit Jalil yesterday.

Li Kian, who won the 200m, 400m and 800m and running second yesterday, was sixth on receiving the baton from Chiang Choon Meng. But the 16-year-old, who was also a member of the 4x100m quartet who won gold on Wednesday, steadily caught up with the five runners in front and gave third runner Yap Chee Hong the lead. Chee Hong and fourth runner Ong Wai Keat never let up to win in 3:40.32s. Royal Military College took the silver in 3:48.73 while Methodist Boys School KL took the bronze in 3:55.16.

"I was not concentrating on the amount of ground I had to make up, but as soon as I passed the 200m, I knew I could grab the lead," said Li Kian.

Sri Sentosa also had an easy win in the Girls' Under-15 4x400m winning in 4:30.50, a massive 27 seconds ahead of silver medallists SMP Kuen Cheng who clocked 4:57.16. Methodist Girls School took the bronze in 5:02.88.

"Although my team-mates opened a big gap early in the race, I decided to sprint in the final 100 metres to achieve a good time," said fourth runner Teong Sui Men.

SMK Sri Sentosa were the overall champions with 36 gold, 22 silver and six bronze medals. SMP Kuen Cheng were a distant second with seven gold, five silver and nine bronze and Royal Military College third with six gold, 14 silver and five bronze.
