

# **THEATRE TO EXPOSE STUDENTS TO CREATIVE INDUSTRY**

KUALA LUMPUR, March 24 (Bernama) -- Students should be exposed to theatre to enable them to explore other fields in the creative industry, National Arts Academy Director Omar Awang said.

He said students should be exposed to theatre at an early stage to nurture their interest in the creative industry like acting, directing, stage management, filming and cinematography.

"Theatre can help them get better jobs in the creative industry," he told Bernama.
