

UNNECESSARY FOR OPPOSITION TO TWIST EVERYTHING - NONG CHIK

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 17 (Bernama) -- It is unnecessary for the opposition to put a twist on all genuine efforts by the Barisan Nasional (BN) government, said

Federal Territories and Urban Well-being Minister Datuk Raja Nong Chik Raja Zainal Abidin.

He hoped that people could evaluate BN's efforts for themselves and not be influenced by the opposition's tactics.

"They twist and turn everything done by the government, as though we don't have good intentions and only they have good intentions," he said during a press conference after the Malaysia Laptop distribution ceremony at Lembah Pantai here today.

He emphasised that the preparations for the 13th general election was more detailed, focused and in-depth compared to 2008 and was confident the Batu parliamentary seat could be wrested from Parti Keadilan Rakyat this time.

Raja Nong Chik further remarked that the younger generation of today were smart enough to observe what was going on around them and evaluate the true situation.
